SILIGURI - A BRIEF PROFILE OF THE CITY

1.0 INTRODUCTION :

Siliguri , the gate way to the North East India is not only of vital importance to the State of West Bengal but India as a whole. Located at the foot hills of Himalayas on the verge of Terai, it presents the picturesque glimpse of the Himalayan ranges establishing its inmate charm to a visitor. Though the settlement started initially with the tea plantation and a junction station to change over to the Toy train for Darjeeling in 1880 it acquired the status of Sub Divisional town in 1907 . Though by thirties it had gained weightage as a town, it was confirmed Municipal status only in 1950.

The independence of India in 1947 provided a boom for the growth of the town with the continuous streams of inflow of refugees from the then East Pakistan. Siliguri is also re-discovered as the most vulnerable nodal point in the narrow corridor that links North Eastern States with the rest of India. Assam rail link in 1951 and broad gauge railway links with New Jalpaiguri in 1962 paved the way for its unquestionable supremacy as a primary trading Centre not only for Assam but also for Bhutan, Sikkim and Eastern Nepal as well. The Chinese aggression in 1962 and the declaration of National Emergency put the town in the strategic map of India with renewed importance.

Presently Siliguri is the hub of the Rail Road net work in the region connecting Assam, North Bengal, Bhutan, Sikkim and Eastern Nepal with the rest of West Bengal and India.

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The strategic location in the transportation net work of North Eastern India has helped in its growth as a primary trade and distribution centers of North Bengal.

Siliguri has also gained considerable importance in recent times due to signing of the treaty between India and China on opening up of trade relations through **NATHU- LA - PASS** . This has created prospect for development of the city as an international transshipment hubs, as a center for logistics and international trade .One of the most striking features of the town is the active people's participation of all the strata of the society in almost all the development initiatives as also on the issues of basic services of the Civic body.

2.1 LOCATION AND BOUNDARY :

Siliguri is the head quarter of the plains Sub Division of Darjeeling District , situated at 26⁰ 43 ' North Latitude and 88⁰ 26 ' East Longitude and 392 feet above mean sea level and in the foot hills of Himalayas on the banks of the river Mahananda. Siliguri is located in the narrow corridor connecting North-East with the rest of India with Bhutan in the North-East , Bangladesh in the south and Nepal in the west.

2.2 AREA AND POPULATION :

2.2.1 From a small village with a population of only 784 in 1901 , It has grown into a big city with a population of more than 6 lakh . Potential and process of urban growth and development received recognition in 1931 when it became a non-Municipal town which was followed by its declaration as a Municipal Town in 1950 . Siliguri Municipality with an area of 15.54 sq.km. was upgraded to Siliguri Municipal Corporation in 1994 with an area of 41.90 sq. Km comprising the areas of the districts of Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri in the State of West Bengal. Presently it has been divided into 47 wards, grouped into 5 (five) Borough Offices headed by an elected representative as Chairman or Chairperson and Borough Officer on the administrative Part.

2.2.2 Siliguri urban agglomeration is spread in the districts of Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling. It includes the Bagdogra airport and Cantonment area to the West, New Jalpaiguri Railway Station to the South and Dabgram area to the North and East. The population of the town was only 10500 in 1941 but suddenly tripled to 32,500 in 1951. Since then the town has been growing at a rate higher than the growth rate of urban population in India. The population as per 1991 census was 2,27,000 with a population density of

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14,600 persons per sq. km. During 1971 –81 it was recorded a growth rate of 57.8 % compared to the National average of 25 % and the West Bengal average of 31.6 %. The population of the town as per census figures from 1931 to 2001 are presented below :

2.2.3 Siliguri witnessed a significant growth of population during the last decades and it has shown a consistently high rate of population growth since 1931. From a population of about 6,000 in the year 1931 the population has increased to more than 5,00,000 in 2002. The decennial growth rate of population of Siliguri Municipality was 46 % during 1981- 1991 as against 29.49 % in urban West Bengal and 36.47 % in Urban India. During the last decade i.e. 1991-2001 the growth rate was 48%. Now its population is 4.70 lakhs as per CENSUS - 2001 and the total Corporation area is 41.90 Sq. Km. comprising 47 wards, grouped into 5 (five) Borough Offices , headed by an elected representative as Chair man and Borough Officer on the administrative Part. Average population density is 11,224 persons per Sq. Km. as per CENSUS – 2001. Siliguri Municipal Corporation has to provide for creation of infrastructure for large number of floating population visiting Siliguri for trade and commerce , employment and tourism from the adjacent areas and also from outside of the city every day .

THE PROJECT:

Notice Inviting Expression of Interest

Siliguri Municipal Corporation hereby invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from reputed Indian companies or International companies or Joint Ventures (JV) for development of a Solid Waste Processing Facility at Siliguri, West Bengal, India on a Public Private Partnership basis.

1.0 The scope of work envisioned for the Solid Waste Management Facility is as follows:

- I. Treatment and processing of municipal solid waste preferably waste fuelled electricity generation plant using Pyromex “Waste to Energy” Technology.
- II. The existing Corporation dumping ground has an area of 28 acres of land situated at Eastern Bye Pass near Donbosco School, Siliguri, Dist-Darjeeling, State-West Bengal.
- III. *The Project will be “build, own and operate pattern with Solid Waste Processing facilities to handle mixed Municipal Wastes, Clinical, Industrial & Hazardous Solid Waste generated per day along with the already dumped wastes within a certain period.*
- IV. *The Project will be on a Public-Private Partnership basis for the purpose of operating waste management project at Siliguri in the existing dumping ground near Eastern Bye-pass on designed, built, finance & operate basis with the Siliguri Municipal Corporation (First Party). The scope of works include development, planning and designing with full financing for a Pyromex “Waste to Energy” MSW processing & disposal facilities to take all the Municipal Waste generated in Siliguri Region including Clinical Hospital wastes etc. for a term of 25 years with necessary extension.*
- V. *The power generated from the Plant may be supplied to West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Ltd.*
- VI. *The required area of land will be provided for the Project may be through Lease Deed or other legal manners and the rest of entire area will be vacated or cleaned the existing dumping ground for use of other purposes for the interest of the Corporation within a period of 5 years from the date of commencement of the project by the Second Party, i.e. Successful Bidder(s).*

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- VII. The Municipal Waste presently generated is about 400 MT per day .
- VIII. The Project should be in conformity with the Municipal Solid Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000, Bio Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998, Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 and its amendment in 2003, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and other related Acts, Rules and regulations of the Central and State Government.

There shall be a Board of Directors of 7 (Seven) members or the number of members may be decided jointly and the Mayor of Siliguri Municipal Corporation shall be the Chairman or Chair person of the Board of Directors and other two members on part of the Corporation Authority and four members on part of the Private Company or private entrepreneur. This may be amended mutually if necessary from time to time.

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9.0 AMENDMENTS TO EOI DOCUMENT :

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Eoi, SMC may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective applicant, modify the Eoi document by issuance of a 'Note of clarification'. The Note of clarification will be sent in writing to all the applicant agencies that have purchased the Eoi Document, for incorporation in the Pre-Eoi Document and it will be binding on every applicant.

13.0 EOI EVALUATION :

The Eoi submitted shall be evaluated by an Empowered or Expert Committee, which would determine the criteria for evaluation of the technical and financial capability of the applicant private sector agencies. Each of the applicant agencies will be asked by the Empowered or Expert Committee to make a one-to-one PowerPoint presentation of the Concept Plan and the management plan before the Committee on date, time and venue to be notified and communicated to the applicant agencies in due course. The Empowered Committee may take the help of external experts in the concerned fields. Such experts may also attend the PowerPoint presentation if necessary. After the presentation is made, the Eoi applicants will have to supply a soft copy of the said PPT presentation to the Committee for evaluation. The PPT presentation should be in line with the technical concept plan submitted by the Eoi applicant. Material deviation of the PPT presentation from the technical concept plan submitted shall be viewed adversely.
